Fit to be Tied

Curious about tying up your partner? Or being restrained yourself? Bondage may not be for everyone, but many feel less inhibited, able to explore sexual fantasies and enjoy sex in a way they wouldn't allow themselves to otherwise. Here are a few basics about what's inside!



Rope can be used to restrain, but if you are feeling artistic, use it to create a little work of art at the same time. Lace the rope through your lover's erogenous zones to promote orgasms and excitement. When using any rope, make sure it has a soft feel, and leave enough space to insert a finger between the body and rope to prevent cutting off circulation!

Safety First: Even if you feel you know your partner inside and out, safe words are important for quick communication with each other, without ruining the mood. We suggest something simple and easy to remember, like green, yellow and red. Just like a stoplight, green indicates full speed ahead, yellow means slow down/pause a moment, and red should be used when play should be completely and immediately stopped. If one is unable to speak, use hand signals or head nodding.
